```

YouGov Polimetrix interviewed 1687 respondents who were then matched down to a sample of 1500 to produce the final dataset. The respondents were matched on gender, age, race, education, party identification, ideology, and political interest. YouGov Polimetrix then weighted the matched set of survey respondents to known marginals for the general population of the United States from the 2006 American Community Survey. Those marginals are shown below.
